The first annual Smoke n' Steam BBQ grilling competition event will be held on the Audrey Avenue extension in the beautiful and historic downtown Hamlet of Oyster Bay, NY, Saturday, May 10, 2008, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The event is organized by the Oyster Bay Railroad Museum, and sanctioned by the New England Barbecue Society.

Grilling teams from throughout the New York area will be competing for prizes in four categories: beefsteak, pork chop, chicken, and oysters. Local Oyster Bay oysters will be provided courtesy of Frank M. Flower & Son.

“This is very exciting for the Oyster Bay Railroad Museum (OBRM) to be hosting this event. It is an opportunity to gain awareness about BBQ grilling events that are so popular throughout the country, as well as an opportunity to let attendees know how our museum is progressing.” said Ben Jankowski, Oyster Bay Railroad Museum Chairman.

The OBRM displays and updates on our accomplishments are displayed at our new Preview Center, located at 102 Audrey Avenue. The Preview Center will be open throughout our Smoke n' Steam event, but also every weekend, starting May 3, 2008, on Saturday's and Sunday's, from 12 noon until 4:00 p.m. Museum merchandise will also be available for purchase at the Preview Center, as well as special Smoke 'n Steam commemorative T-shirts.

Entertainment will be provided by the blues/rock band Cadillac Moon, from 12 noon to 3:00 p.m., followed the awards ceremony at 3:30 p.m. There are several other events within walking distance of the grilling competition, including the Doubleday Babcock Senior Center Appraisal Day, and the Oyster Bay Presbyterian Church's annual thrift sale.
